

IRAN AND SYRIA SANCTIONS CUSTOMER STATEMENT

International pressure is increasing on both Iran and Syria for additional sanctions and multilateral action against certain types of transactions.

TNT Number One Business Principle is to comply with all laws, rules and regulations and trade regulations imposed by United Nations, European Union, United States and Australia and other regulatory bodies.

Many of these sanctions are targeted at the nuclear, petroleum, banking and insurance industries, also against individuals, organizations and companies that have been identified by and not limited to; the United Nations, European Union, United States and Australia.

New sanctions have been imposed on people and entities in Iran and Syria.

When shipping commodities, information and/or technology, which are not allowed to be exported freely to Iran or Syria, an appropriate license is required or a statement from the Customer that No License is Required (NLR) and the annotated exemptions.

As part of TNT's Export Control compliance, TNT requires the below Statement to be completed and signed before accepting your goods for transportation to Iran and/or Syria effective immediately. Please place and print this statement on your company letterhead.
